FACTS ABOUT THE PROJECT:

PLACE AND DATE: Berlin, May $01^{st} - 08^{th}$ 2018

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PARTICIPANTS: 25

COUNTRIES: Germany, Azerbaijan, Serbia, Georgia, Portugal, Slovakia, Kosovo*UN

Resolution, Italy and Albania.

LANGUAGE: The official language of the project is English.

The TC "Community for All" is part of Multi-Activity project of two training courses "Building Trust through Cooperation". The project will provide the participants with new NFE techniques in the Music, Satire/Comics, Understand of Narrative. The project aims at positively affecting the condition of migrants/refugees in the following ways:

- An open discussion on the condition of refugees, engaging against stereotypes and xenophobic sentiments among local populations
- Peace building through conflict resolution activities, using NFE methods, which aims to develop awareness and competences of youngsters in the field.

ACTIVITIES AND METHODS:

The main objective of the project is to endow youth/social workers and educators with skill sets and NFE tools related to narrative, satire and comics, using the aforementioned raise awareness about refugee issues. The focus being on fighting xenophobia and racism, supporting person to person reconciliation methods through the lens of a multi-cultural group. Promoting good practices of understanding and integration via a group consisting of multiple nationalities, religious and ethnic backgrounds. The involvement of youth/social workers is essential due to the fact that they can stimulate and activate integration processes in their society, while at the same time sharing best practices from the view of multiple nationalities. As the project also aims to strengthen partner organizations' operations in the fields of the proposal, the participating youth operators will be selected among the professional staff resources of each partner organization.

RESPONSABILITIES

Reimbursement of travel costs will only be done upon *full attendance* in the training programme (up to 80%) and *presentation of the original tickets* with **BOARDING PASSES and RECEIPT/INVOICES**. Missing tickets will not be reimbursed.

Following the guide lines of the Erasmus + programme the travel must be realized by the participants on direct way within maximum 2 days before or after the project (this days ARE NOT COVERED BY THE PROJECT).

In case of longer stays or indirect travelling (holiday travel etc.) there is no chance of reimbursement of travel costs. Please note if you bought your ticket in your local currency which might be different than EUR, we will calculate your travel costs according to the exchange rates from official European Commission website for the month of ticket purchase

HOW TO REACH THE HOSTEL FROM AIRPORT?

From Tegel airport TXL you can take the following route:

Bus TXL (Direction S+U Alexanderplatz)

8 min ride then Get off Beusselstr.

And Change to

Bus 106 (Direction U Seestr.)

4 min ride

Get off Sylter Str.

From there 8-10 min walking distance to the Hostel

From Schonafeld airport SXF you can take the following route:

Train S45 (Direction Sudkreuz)

33 min ride then Get off Berlin Sudkreuz

And Change to

Bus 106 (Direction U Seestr.)

37 min ride

Get off Sylter Str.

From there 8-10 min walking distance
