#### ABOUT THE PROJEC

Rural areas perform important economic functions in the sphere of production, demographics, recreation, culture, nature conservation and social control over the territory.

The development of rural areas represents one of the most important achievement of the European Union since contributes to the economical balance between cities and countryside.

Social entrepreneurship for rural areas is a 2 stage Erasmus+ project that aims at providing rural youth and active members of society with skills to identify the different business opportunities that exist in rural areas and start their own enterprise.

The project follows the logical frame - during the 1st rage, we will introduce to participants the concept of social entrepreneurship and then continue with providing tools for the future development of their own business ideas to become entrepreneurs working towards social good and bringing the benefits to their rural areas.

After the 1st stage, participants will get a midterm task to be done among national teams or individually - make research in their own communities regarding the need for the product/ service and bring to the second stage of the project their final concept of the social enterprise they would like to develop.

During the 2nd stage, we will be already working on participant's own future social enterprise's business plan (social/environmental mission, description of the main product and service offerings, market analysis, sales plan, financial analysis, funding, etc.) and we will also give a special attention to developing of their entrepreneurial, leadership and managerial skills.

#### **OBJECTIVES**

- •To develop youth in rural communities and increase the capacity of young leaders living in rural areas to become active multipliers of community engagement
- •To raise awareness of participants about the potential of rural areas and existing asset
- •To inspire them and provide with the skills on how to identify the business opportunities that exist in rural areas, develop the idea and start new businesses
- •To inform about the benefits that rural entrepreneurship can produce in their communities
- To make young people stay in rural areas and prevent brain drain
- •To allow the participants to get to know each other and learn from each other's realities and projects, and set up projects together for the future, to create more opportunities in the countryside across Europe
- To get rural young people interested in international youth activities and Erasmus+ projects through sharing information about these opportunities

### **PARTICIPANTS**

In order to ensure the project will be maximum efficient and beneficial, it will be obligatory for participants to participate in both stages of the project.

We are looking for a team of 28 participants:

5 from Georgia,

5 from Czech Republic,

3 from Lebanon, Belarus, Azerbajian, Slovakia, Greece, and Latvia.

The profile of the participants for both stage is the following\*:

- 1. Youth workers and active members of society working in rural areas or isolated places (islands, mountainous regions, less serviced areas, less access to information, etc.) who are engaged or willing to engage in social entrepreneurship, who have social innovative ideas that have the potential to solve a problem in the rural areas and create sustainable future;
  - 2. Willingness to prepare the concept of a new SE together with its national team and to implement it within their communities.
    - 3. Have knowledge of the concept of SE and its main elements;
      - 4. Able to communicate in English;
        - 5. Age above 21;

The priority is given to the participants who have personal experience connected with the project topic, ambition, and interest to use social entrepreneurship to implement a social project in rural areas and youth with fewer opportunities (by educational, economical, social, geographical point of view

\* In case if there is any changes in the participants list (because of health problem, changes regarding the plans, etc.) the missing participants will be replaced by a new one, who passes the same procedures like for the 1st stage, in addition, the candidate for the 2nd stage should already have the basic knowledge in the field of social entrepreneurship and needs to be involved in the preparation of mid-term task.



Participans will be allocated in 3 or 4 bedded rooms and will be divided according to gender but different nationalities.

3 meals will be provided plus healthy breaks during the day.

Vegetarian and vegan options available on request.

Alcohol comsuption is not allowed: however during cultural evening tasting of traditional alcoholic beverage will be tolerated.
