Summary of the project:

Active Groups- social changes! Is a youth exchange between 4 different countries that will be realized by young active people in Cyprus . This project will bring together 36 youngsters from different backgrounds among EU countries to act together as a team. The mission of this one week of youth exchanges is to spread information about EU opportunities for young people and to empower them to be active citizens of Europe. The main goal of this project is to show young people, regardless of the difficult background they have, how to take an active role in the life of their community and provide them possibility to get new skills and knowledge and increase their ability to create projects tackling and solving the common community problems.

Team building activities will be one of the main tool of this education. A team sport is an activity in which a group of individuals, on the same team, work together to accomplish an ultimate goal. Outdoor activities and playful methods will break social, cultural and language barriers among youngsters and encourage them to work together.

SAFETY AND INSURANCE

Travel and accident insurance is a responsibility of the participants. You shall obtain the European Health Insurance Card in your city. it's free and gives you access to medical care of the host country. You are also advised to buy a regular travel and/ or accident insurance during your travel and your whole stay.

Budget: :

Food, accommodation and local travel costs (only during the activity program) will be covered 100% by the grant from local National Agency of Erasmus+.

Travel costs reimbursement maximum limit for Polish participants is 275 euro. After sending their tickets and boarding cards, participants will receive the reimbursement of their travel costs. Travel (flights, other means of transport) expenses are compensated (up to 100%), based on the actual expenses incurred and the distance from your location of residence to the location of the project (Serik,Antalya,Turkey).
