★ Project Summary:

The Youth Exchange **"Youth against Modern Day Addictions**" aspires to unite 43 young people from 6 different Countries, from all corners of Europe and neighboring countries (i.e. Slovakia, Bulgaria, Romania, Lithuania, Italy and Greece). It will take place in **Athens, Greece** from **13 to 24 February 2020**.

During this project we will focus on the face of modern days' addictions and addictive behaviors, which do not only include chemical substances, but have extended to a wide variety of different behaviors, such as work holism, smart phone/ social media/ video games over-usage, as well as behaviors related to the excessive preoccupation with appearance, such as tanning, plastic surgery or physical exercise. The vast majority of modern people engage in some of those behaviors that often develop into addictive habits that dominate lives, just like alcohol or drug abuse.

Through this Youth Exchange we will exchange knowledge, share personal experiences and explore together different local realities concerning those behaviors among the youth. We will try to identify the reasons that lie beneath this situation, its significance and ways to overcome the negative effects, as well as offer strong motivation for the youth to act locally and become socially aware, acting on a positive and proactive manner.

Ø To exchange knowledge and valuable experiences concerning the different faces and the extent of psychological dependence and addictions

Travel Reimbursement Rules \Rightarrow

1) APV and exchange participants are expected to buy their own tickets (flights & other means of transportation to reach the airport) before the meeting.

2) The reimbursement for the APV will be done in an individual basis (for the Youth Exchange it will be done in a group basis) via bank transfer. For this you will need to send us your bank account details ("Individual Bank account details" document). You may either send us this document signed and scanned before the APV meeting, or fill it in during the meeting.

3) Reimbursement will be done in **Euros**. If you buy your tickets in other local currency, the reimbursement in Euros will be calculated according to the exchange rates of the Official Tool from the European Commission (InforEuro: <u>http://ec.europa.eu/budget/graphs/inforeuro.html</u>) for the month of ticket purchase.

4) Please note that TAXI drives are NOT reimbursed (except for very special cases, such as general strike of public transportation means)

5) The travel of the participants must be from the country of their sending organization to Athens and back, during the **meeting`s travel dates (16.12 – morning & 18.12 – any time)**, in order to be eligible for reimbursement

Travel Documents:

Reimbursements are made according to the travel documents submitted: **No payment will be made**

without a proof of your expenses!

Therefore KEEP ALL YOUR FLIGHT/TRAIN/BUS TICKETS, BOARDING PASSES, INVOICES ETC WITH YOU AND DO NOT THROW THEM AWAY!

Participants:

Team Composition

Each Country's team should consist of 7 participants: 6 young people (18-30 years old) + 1 leader.

The representative that will come to the APV must be one of these 7 participants. There is no age limit for the leader.

Selection Criteria

<u>Necessary conditions:</u>

- Age (18-30)
- Ability to communicate fluently in English
- Citizenship or long-term residence in the respective partner country (e.g. for studies/work or long-term volunteering project), where your organization is based
- Gender balanced teams
- *High interest in the subject and full commitment for active participation throughout the project*

Please make sure that your participants are very well aware that this Youth Exchange is NOT a free vacation !

Preferable characteristics:

- Active involvement in local community (e.g. volunteering, active member in an NGO)
- Social & economical obstacles (e.g. NEETs, low family income, belonging in some type of socially marginalized group etc).

However, please note that the facilities and arrangements of this exchange are **not suitable** for people with physical or mental special needs.

Working Methods:

• The main methods we will use during the program will be based on **non-formal education activities** such as:

ice-breaking and team-building activities, brainstorming, group discussions, role-play games,

storytelling evenings, creative activities, short-movie-making workshop, cultural visits

and intercultural nights

One of the main objectives of the project is to promote a sense of individual responsibility, empowerment and participatory approach!

To achieve that a special working method will be applied during the project:

Each team will take up the **role of the facilitator** for a number of activities. This role includes responsibility for:

- Design of the activity prior to the project (basic structure, objectives and outcomes)
- Organization of the activity prior to the project (separation in groups, rules, deliverables, preparation of materials needed etc)
- Coordination/Facilitation of the activity during the project (assuming active role as facilitators, explaining the activity to the rest of participants, time-management, troubleshooting etc)
 - ➔ During the APV we will discuss about the <u>allocation of activities</u>, for which each team will

be the responsible facilitator

Dissemination:

In order to receive the grant for the reimbursements, there is a need to **publicize the program beforehand** and disseminate the outcomes afterwards.

Therefore, you are kindly requested to publicize the project's summary, which we sent you along with the required logos (EU flag,

Greek NA etc), on your organization's website and distribute information about the project on social media.



After the project, the same process should be repeated for the project's press release, outcomes, photos and any other audiovisual material.
