..... If you travel by airplane from another country
First you will get Istanbul-Turkey plane from your home city
Then you will take another airplane from İstanbul to Siirt.

Turkey Project Team will welcome you at Siirt Airport
When arrived to Siirt you will be travelling by bus . The estimated time for Siirt city center is 10 minutes.

* You can change your money into Turkish lira at Istanbul Airport or a nearby currency office

IMPORTANT NOTE ;




Reimbursement of your travel costs will be done during the event in EUR regardless of the currency indicated on your ticket or receipt/invoice. The exchange rate is based on the European Commission's rate for February 2020.

Please make sure that:

- Your travel cost can only be reimbursed up to the amount indicated on your tickets, as the REAL cost with the limits set up by the host (according to the planned budget) and consulted before any ticket purchase.
- You should present the original tickets with boarding passes and receipt/invoices, and provide them to the host's staff. So please keep them all.
- Note that all the returning tickets and invoices should be sent within one week after the activity, in order to fully cover and justify the reimbursement of your travel. Missing or lost tickets will cause the reduction in reimbursement amount for particular participant or organization during the next activities.
- TAXI bills will not be accepted in general, except in situations where no other means of transport was possible, and only if it was earlier agreed with the hosting organization via e-mail.
- Travel costs that occur more than 72 hours before OR after the activity will not be taken into consideration, therefore cannot be reimbursed.
- All the costs that occurred before the start of the coordination meeting or after the departure will not be taken into consideration (for example: accommodation costs, travel to other destinations, costs of activities not included in the programme, etc). VISAS, TRAVEL DOCUMENTS AND INSURANCE

- EU members s and citizens of selected countries in the Western Balkans, can make entry and exit to Turkey with a valid Passport,
 - If You Travel to Turkey with your public Passport , you may need visa (If your country requires visa to Turkey and also cost for visa will not be covered by our organization)
 - Invitation Letters will be sent to the participants from the participating countries by the Host Organization.
 - In Mobility week before coming to Turkey , we strongly recommend you to purchase a travel insurance.
 - Mobility Week is 20- 26 May 2021 Turkey / Siirt
 - Participants can come to Turkey 3 days before Mobility .
 - Participants can leave Turkey 3 days after mobility

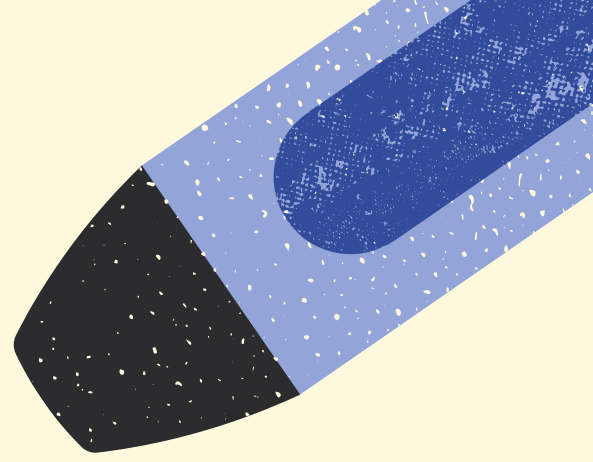
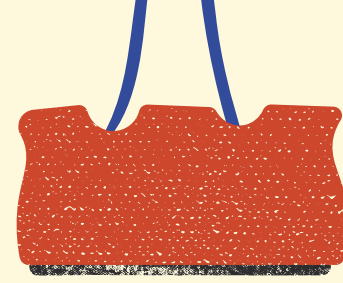
