Project Summary: Save Today for Safe Tomorrows - Güvenli Yarınlar için Bugün Biriktir! aims to fill the gap in the financial literacy area by designing tailor made trainings in parallel with the needs of the young people and providing a pilot training to the participants. Today, whole society became a consumption society and are not aware of the dangers of overconsuming/spending. EU and COVID-19 crises showed whole world that impact of financial crises are becoming greater. Since there is not any kind of financial literacy trainings/methodology given in schools, young people who are affected the most, may not know how to react during the economic crisis period and how to prepare/adapt themselves to it. Therefore, our project will fill this gap by providing proper training to the young people. Even though it is mostly ignored, social and economic problems are interrelated. Tackling only one problem will not have full impact on the disadvantaged people. By this training, young people and the participating organizations in the area will be able to tackle with the economic issues that disadvantaged youth faces.

Insurance: According to our National Agency, it is participant's responsibility to make the insurance arrangements. Please make your travel insurance (covering health issues) prior to coming to the training. It is the only requirement asked from the participants.

Other expenses such as travel, accomodation, meals and etc. will be covered by the Project in parallel with the rules of Erasmus+ Programme.



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TRAVEL

You have to use the most economical way (i.e. economy class for planes/busses, no use of taxi – only the public transportation etc.) of travel. Otherwise, those costs cannot be reimbursed. It is important for you to collect all receipts for reimbursement.

Please note that, travel costs are based on the address of your organization. If any of the participants travels from a near distance the travel subsistence will be lower as stated by the Erasmus+ Programme rules:

100 - 499 km: 180 €

500 - 1999 km: 275 €

Also, according to our National Agency, if any of the participants would like to travel earlier and/or stay in Turkey. However, you will have to cover your own the other expenses. The limit of the extra duration is 3 days in total. Above 3 days, NA stated that you may not recover some of the travel costs in such cases.

Travel reimbursements will be done by cash at the last day of the training upon the submission of travel documents to us.

Travel Costs per Country:

- We recommend you to use www.skyscanner.com or www.momondo.com to find the most convenient flight.
- Please let us know before you buy the tickets.
- These amounts represent the maximum that can be reimbursed. However, we kindly recommend to be considerate and rather choose environmentally friendly and economic ways of transportation.

REIMBURSEMENT

The Programme is financed by Erasmus+ program, meaning that the travel costs, food and accommodation will be covered by the hosting organization. To receive the reimbursement you need to provide us with all the original documents of transportation (plane, train or bus) that are used during your trip from the departure city to the training venue. This includes: tickets, receipts, boarding passes, invoices. We cannot reimburse: travel costs without the above proofs, taxi, blablacar, Uber.

On the reimbursement day, transportation tickets will be examined and subjected to online verification. After the verification & approval, reimbursements will be done by cash at the last day of the programme.

Reimbursement will be done in EURO (only small amounts can be paid in Turkish Liras, i.e amounts under 5 or 10 EURO) regardless of the mentioned currency in tickets, receipts and invoices. All tickets purchased in another currency other than Euro will be converted and calculated according to the current exchange rate when the reimbursement is made.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Check if your travel documents (passport or ID for participants from countries that can enter Turkey with ID) are valid.
- Remember about travel documents. Do not forget to collect your boarding passes and any other bills/tickets from your travel.
- Take medicines that you use and please let us know in the application form.
- Feel free to bring information about your organization and activities that your organizations are doing.
- The programme will include intercultural evening thus you are welcome to bring with you something to taste, some music or anything presenting your culture.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Before the Project

- You must follow deadlines.
- Each organisation need to prepare very well all the participants.
- You should bring materials for cultural night (food, typical clothes, drinks, flag etc), presentation or videos or other materials.



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During the project

- You should attend at least 95% of the program to get reimbursement. (unless there is a force majeure)
- You should respect the program schedule in order to carry out successfully the activities
- You should be actively involved in all activities.

After the Project

- Sharing Project results, visuals, photos on your social media accounts. (and send these shares to us)

COVID-19 Measures upon Entering Turkey

NOTE: PCR and/or antigen test costs will not be covered from the Project.

Within the scope of the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic measures, the following decisions regarding entry to Turkey have been taken by the official authorities of the Republic of Turkey, effective as of March 4, 2022.

Accordingly, passengers who meet at least one of the conditions listed below are allowed to enter Turkey and will also be exempt from the quarantine application.

- 1- Passengers who have received at least two doses of the vaccines approved for emergency use by the World Health Organization or by Turkey (one dose for Johnson & Johnson), who submit a document stating that their most recent vaccination took place at least 14 days earlier;
- 2- Passengers who submit a document issued by the relevant country's official authorities stating that they have had the virus within the last 6 months. The 6-month period starts from the 28th day of the first PCR positive test result; and
- 3- Passengers who, before entering Turkey, present a negative PCR test result received within the last 72 hours or a negative rapid antigen test taken within the last 48 hours.

- Passengers under the age of 12 are exempted from the PCR/antigen test report and the submission of a vaccine certificate.
- The requirements listed above do not apply for transfer passengers from international line to international line.
- Seamen and truck drivers are exempted from SARS-CoV-2 PCR testing and the quarantine application.
- It is obligatory for all passengers to wear masks at the airports and during the flights.
- The vaccination certificates of Serbia, Hungary, Kazakhstan, Iraq, Libya, Japan, Indonesia, Philippines, Vietnam and Egypt are accepted by the Republic of Turkey for passengers who will enter Turkey with a vaccination certificate.



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
