SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

In the Global Era, the easy access to the internet has made information about everything available very close to us, but this easy access doesn't guarantee the credibility or authenticity of the information, because it could often be unstructured or false. As social media continues expanding its role in young people's lives, the educational systems cannot keep up with the problems created by the amount of information being spread constantly. Fake news spreads through the internet and the media, scammers try to conduct fake charity campaigns, personal information is stolen and used by cybercriminals, etc. While social media now plays a vital role in the everyday lives of young people as citizens, education systems across the developed world have been slow to react. Extremist groups rely on false promises of status and purpose, manipulation, conspiracy, and divisive rhetoric to exploit young people online. Against these methods, critical thinking skills and media literacy, social and emotional skills and meaningful digital citizenship capacities are a strong defense. Today's young people may be digital natives, but they still need to be taught how to stay safe, make their voices heard and play a positive role as citizens in the online space. These conditions require each individual to categorize and select info carefully. The mixture of valid and reliable information and lies demands each individual be able to critically examine it. Reflective, critical, and creative thinking abilities are required to do it. Critical thinking ability is required to evaluate the quality of information. Creative thinking ability is necessary to produce other and required information. Reflective thinking ability is required to come up with a correct and appropriate decision. "Online citizens" seek to meet this need. The project is designed to teach 18 to 30-year-olds about media literacy, critical thinking and digital citizenship, encouraging young people to be positive voices online while increasing their resilience to hate and extremism. Using a non-formal educational approach, the project helps the participants become more informed citizens, critical consumers and empowered producers of content.

- 8 participants (17-30 years old, 3 of them with fewer opportunities) + 2 group leaders (can be older) per country

- Keen to increase knowledge on the subject of the project.

- Motivated to address critical thinking and media literacy in their communities, as well as issues related to youth internationally, and issues related to democratic citizenship.

- Ready to work in an intercultural learning environment, to contribute to successful project implementation.

- Motivated to take part in Erasmus + project, work in an international team and share their experiences in the follow-up period;

- Have a communicative level of English and be able to take part in preparatory online meetings, youth exchange and follow-up activities.
