Genesis - in the Czech Republic Global Youth Union - in Armenia







"Human Rights Values" is an international Erasmus+ project that will introduce, train and present key ideas of human rights issues with connection to media literacy. Participants will be actively involved in presenting human rights issues of their countries and in general and will have the opportunity to discuss their opinions with a group. This project will be 5-months learning program and will aim at developing own project in your community.

Human rights education will allow participants to discuss important issues as discrimination and marginalization, social justice, extremisms, (medial) perception of religions and human rights. Knowledge that will be obtained from the TC will improve skills in human rights education, mentorship, putting gained knowledge into practice and the quality of participants' work with young people.

The project will consist of two stages - two training courses which will focus on non-formal education via creativity and innovation.

1st stage: Czech Republic, 13.3.2023 - 19.3.20232nd stage: Lori Armenia, 25.5.2023 - 31.5.2023



OBJECTIVES

The project aims at promoting knowledge about different backgrounds, values and cultures. The main focus will be set on making all the participants become aware of vulnerable groups to radicalization within our societies and allow participants to discover the different situations of other participating countries, by the end of the TC the participants will be more aware of the importance of providing opportunities for various target groups. We aim to help the participants gain a positive experience of international youth projects and the confidence to become multipliers in promotion of inclusive learning and countering disinformation.

- tolerance towards other intercultural background within local and international voluntary and youth projects
- create materials that promotes peace/tolerance/interfaith harmony and prevents radicalization
- media literacy education

PARTICIPANT PROFILE

We would like to invite people interested in this topics with a communicative level of English. Minimum age is 18 years old. The applicant should be someone associated with a sending organization, volunteer, or a person whose studies are associated with the topic of the project. The applicant doesn't have to have experiences but have to be interested in the topic, and be supported from the sending organization to proceed with dissemination after the project.

Participants will be required to be actively involved during the whole project - sharing ideas, thoughts, opinions during the activities. Participants must be interested in the topic and know the policy and strategies of human rights issues in their country, be able to present data about their country and discuss it with a group.

Participants will be asked to complete several tasks before their arrival to the Czech Republic which will be presented to a group on the project. After the training course, the participants will continue to improve their gained skills using the newly acquired tools, by producing at least one communication material on the topic they work with using any/each of the preferred tools that they will include in an awareness raising/education campaign.

Participants with video-making skills, digital skills are very welcome.

30 EUR will be used for the local transportation in the Czech Republic.

Accommodation, transportation and food will be fully covered with the support of Erasmus+ programme.

The travel costs will be reimbursed for the cheapest and direct way of transport and only under the condition that the participant will take part in the whole project. The travel costs will be reimbursed according to amounts stated in the chart.

It is necessary for the participants to have travel health insurance (this is not covered by the project).

You can take 2 extra days before or after the project.

TRAVEL TIPS

Plan your trip well and choose the best means of transportation. Especially short distance can be often covered by a bus or a train, and flights can be avoided. Travel light, take only as much as you really need.

You can take 2 extra day before or after the project. **However**, we would like to ask you to look for flights that **will be arriving NO later than <u>10am on March 13, 2023</u>**. And **returning flights that will be NOT before <u>5pm March 19, 2023</u>.**

REMEMBER to send us a proposal of your tickets before buying them.

It is necessary that we will APPROVE them first!

Keep invoices of the purchases and boarding passes and tickets so we could reimburse them for you.

MEETING POINT AND TIME







The meeting point will be next to the main train station in Pardubice, by the entrance into the building on **March 13**, 2023 at 3**pm**.

Two ways to get from the airport to the Prague train station:

- 1. Participants who will be landing at the Václav Havel Airport Prague (Letiště Václava Havla Praha) can take **bus 199 or 322** at the bus stop in from of terminal 1 or terminal 2 which will go to Nádraží Veleslavín. Then you need to switch to Metro green line A and get off at the stop **Muzeum.** From here it is either 5 minutes walk to the train station or switch to Metro red line C and continue 1 more stop to **Hlavní Nádraží**. You can buy 40-minute ticket at the bus stop in the ticket vending machine.
- 2. You can take **AE bus** that will take you straight to the Prague train station **Hlavní Nádraží**. The ticket costs 100 czk and you can buy it at the bus driver, it is possible to pay in cash or by a card.

At the train station you take a train to Pardubice hl.n. The journey takes an hour to reach Pardubice. The meeting point will be **in front of the middle entrance into the building latest by 3pm**.


We ask you to avoid promotion videos or formal presentations. Be creative!

WEATHER AND WHAT TO BRING?

WEATHER

The weather in March isn't very predictable. Daytime temperature is likely near 5-6 °C, but it can go near to 11 °C. Sometimes the temperature in afternoons can reach up near 17-18 °C.

During the March last year it was snowing. So we recommend that you check the weather forecast in the Czech Republic before the departure and adjust your selection of clothes to it.
