ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

The venue where the project will take place is <u>Eliofos</u> **Elegant Maisonettes**.


The participants will be accommodated in two-story maisonettes of 4-5 people. All maisonettes include ensuite bathroom and fully equipped kitchen.

The accommodation is a 2-minute walk from a beautiful beach, a 5-minute walk from scenic Polis Camping Site and a 10-minute walk from Latchi harbour where there are plenty of restaurants, coffee shops, bars etc.

Participants will be offered 3 main meals plus 2 coffee breaks per day.













HOW TO REACH THE VENUE

- **1** Fly to Paphos (strongly recommended) or Larnaca airport. If you arrive at Larnaca airport you will need to take a bus to transport you to Paphos airport. You can find the bus schedules <u>here</u>.
- 2 From Paphos airport take the bus no. 613 and stop at Karavela. From Karavela stop take the bus no. 645 and stop at Polis Chrysochous. Click on this <u>link</u> for the bus schedules.
- **3** Follow <u>this</u> route to get from the bus stop to the venue. It takes approximately **25** minutes on foot.


Travel costs will be reimbursed through a bank transfer to each partner organisation once all participants have delivered properly the required reimbursement documents and dissemination proofs.

Keep in mind that we have already kept €30 from your travel reimbursement amount in order to cover some of the activities costs.

TRAVEL INSTRUCTIONS

- You must arrive at the venue on September 27th at 20:00 the latest and depart on October 6th after 08:00 the earliest.
- You can arrive to Cyprus up to 2 days before and depart up to 2 days after the project. If you wish to stay any extra days which do not coincide with the project days (27/09-06/10/2024), you are responsible to cover your food and accommodation expenses.
- Only 1 baggage per person (besides the backpack) is eligible for reimbursement. First class and seat allocation are not reimbursable. Transfer by Taxi/Uber/Bolt (or similar) is also not eligible for reimbursement.
- Make sure that you will not arrive in Ercan airport since your travel expenses will not be eligible for reimbursement.

TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT



To be eligible for reimbursement, you must travel within the designated days as explained in the previous slide.



To be able to reimburse your travel expenses we must receive all original invoices, tickets and boarding passes either in PDF or physical format.



For some airlines, boarding passes expire from your phone application shortly after the flight. In such instances, make sure that you take a screenshot of your boarding pass.



You will be reimbursed only after you complete the dissemination phase of the project.



WHAT TO BRING

- Valid passport or ID card
- Health insurance (EHIC or similar) valid in Cyprus
- Any medicine you take on a regular basis
- Personal hygiene products such as toothbrush, shampoo etc (towels will be provided)
- Comfortable clothing/shoes and your swimsuit
- Drinks and snacks to represent your country on the intercultural night
- Plug adapter
