Logistical aspects



APV

The Advance Planning Visit (APV) will take place on the **16th June 2026** in **Barcelona** (with the 15th and 17th June as travel days)*

Each partner country will participate with **one representative from the organisation**, preferably the **group leader** who will also take part in the Youth Exchange (no age limit applies).

The person attending the APV will be responsible for transmitting all the information, agreements, and practical details discussed during the meeting to both the participants and the partner organisation.

*Participants are allowed to arrive in or leave Spain 2 days before or after the official travel dates at their own expense.

REMEMBER!

Each partner country will participate with:

- 1 Group Leader (no age limit)
- 5 Participants aged 18–30. Among them, 2–3 participants should be young people with fewer opportunities.

The YE will take place from the **21st to 27th July 2026** (the 20th and 28th July as travelling days), in **Sant Fost de Campsentelles**.



Transport



The maximum travel budget per participant is determined by the official Erasmus+ distance calculator, based on the distance between your hometown and Sant Fost de Campsentelles:

Estonia: 395.00 €

Slovakia: 309.00€

Romania: 309.00 €

Greece: 309.00 €

Serbia: 309.00 €

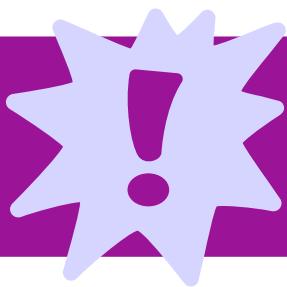
Spain: 28.00 €

Remember to keep all the tickets and boarding passes (train, bus, flight...) for the reimbursements.

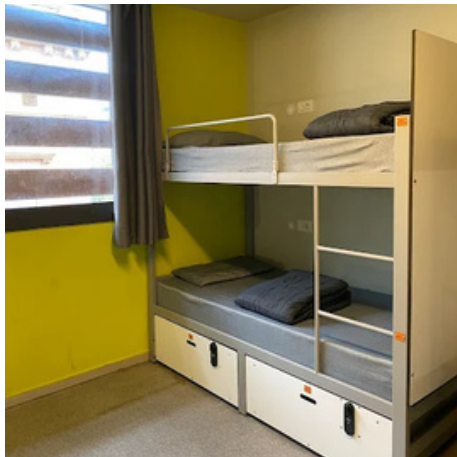
Location

How to get there

The journey from the airport to the accomodation is **+/- 1h**, depending on connection times:

Option 1:

From **Terminal 2** at Barcelona's airport:

1. Take the **R2 Nord** train towards Barcelona and Maçanet Massanes.
 - The train station is located at **Terminal 2**.
(If you arrive at Terminal 1, a free shuttle bus connects you to Terminal 2)
2. Stay on the **R2 Nord** line and get off at Barcelona-Sants (It's a 23-minutes ride / 3 stops).

3. **Walk** 1.2km / 19 min to the accomodation: Carrer Numància, 149, Les Corts, Barcelona.

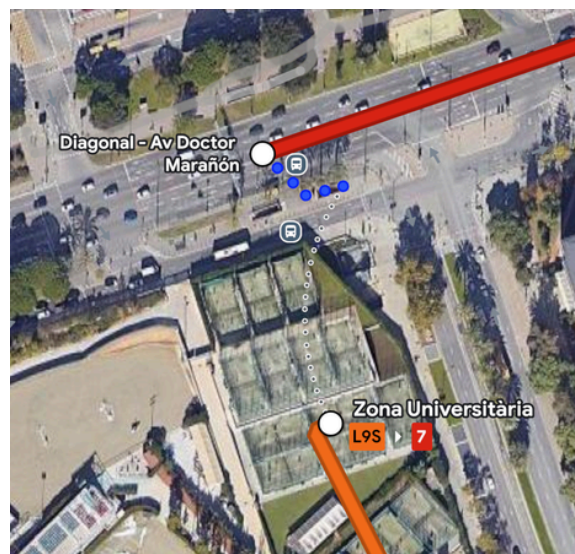
Option 2:

From **Terminal 2** or **Terminal 1** at Barcelona's airport:

1. Take the **L9S** metro towards **Zona Universitària**.
2. Get off in **Zona Universitària** (26 min ride / 13 stops).



3. Walk to the bus stop **Diagonal - Av. Doctor Marañón**, located right next to the metro station, and take **bus number 7** towards Fòrum.



4. Get off at **Diagonal - L'Illa Diagonal** (6 stops / 11-minute ride).
5. Walk to the accommodation: Carrer Numància, 149, Les Corts, Barcelona (3min / 230m).

Rules for leaders



- Every group leader must ensure that their national group prepares and delivers: the energizers, the workshop/session and the Intercultural Night activity.
- Every group leader must forward (send to an e-mail and tell in leader meetings) all information gathered in APV to their own group. This should be done both by email and during the meetings before the Youth Exchange.
- Every group leader has to take care about the procedure of the documents on Erasmus+ Program (save boarding passes, train and bus tickets, etc.) in order to give them to the coordination of the project during and after the YE.
- Every group leader is directly responsible for their group and they must watch over for every participant's safety and wellbeing.
- All group leaders are expected to actively participate in the activities, supporting the facilitation process, supervising the group, and helping whenever needed.
- 30 minutes before dinner the group leader will participate in a 30 minutes briefing.

The organisation reserves the right to expel the participant in case your choice is not to participate actively during the project
